

Carlson Orchard Field Trip



Dear First Grade Families,

The First-grade classes will be going on a field trip to <u>Carlson Orchard</u> in <u>Harvard</u>, <u>MA</u> on <u>Friday</u>, <u>October 13</u>, <u>2023</u> as part of our First-grade Science curriculum. Children should wear comfortable clothing and sneakers. The classes will leave the Burrell School at 9:15 a.m. and return at approximately 1:30 p.m.

Since our eating schedules will be different this day, please be sure that your child eats a hearty breakfast at home and packs a fulfilling snack/drink to bring with us on the trip that will tide him/her over until we return to school for lunch. Field Trips make us hungry! Although we love the Earth, we are asking each child to bring a snack/drink in a large Gallon-sized Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name since lunch boxes will stay at school. Students can also grab a breakfast bag from the cafeteria before we leave to add to these gallon bags if needed. Please be sure that your child's snack/drink is in a disposable container and also has any disposable straws, spoons, napkins, etc. if needed. We will not be able to buy souvenirs, food, or drinks, so please do not send any money with your child. CHAPERONES MAY NOT BUY OR PROVIDE ANY FOOD TO THE STUDENTS.

When we return to school, it will be after the lunch sessions, so no hot lunch options will be available. Each child will either need to bring a separately bagged lunch (as these lunches will stay at school) OR for this day only, students can pre-order a sandwich lunch option from the cafeteria. Please note this on the permission slip below so that the cafeteria will have time to prepare these lunches and have them ready for us for when we return.

Each class will need three adults to chaperone this trip to the Orchard. <u>Chaperones MUST</u> have a <u>CURRENT CORI</u> on file with <u>Mrs. McLaughlin or they cannot be considered at this time.</u> Please let us know if you would like to chaperone, and we will contact you to confirm if you are chosen. Unfortunately, we are not able to accommodate siblings or parents other than chaperones. <u>*If more than 3 chaperones sign up in a class, eligible chaperone names will be drawn from a hat.*</u>
